A condemned ambassador car of this office the details of which are given below will be sold by public auction on 15.01.2020 at 11:30 AM at Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR), 35, Ferozeshah Road, New Delhi – 110001.

Instructions, Terms & conditions of the auction/sale are as under:

1. The vehicle is offered for disposal on “**AS IS WHERE IS**” basis. Taxes and duties if any that may be levied by Government will have to be met by the buyer.
2. Before commencement of the auction, every intending bidder will have to deposit for this vehicle a sum of Rs.5,000/- in cash, which will be refunded to the unsuccessful bidder after the auction proceedings are over.
3. The successful bidder will have to pay 25% of the bid amount in cash immediately on the spot failing which the deposit amount of Rs.5,000/- will be forfeited. The balance 75% amount will have to be paid within next 2 working days of the auction failing which the bid amount 25% as deposited by successful bidder will be forfeited.
4. The vehicle will be handed over only after the receipt of full payment and has to be lifted by the successful bidder at their own expenses within 04 days of completion of deal failing which ground rent at the rate of Rs.500/- day will be charged. No assistance/transportation will be provided by ICHR. Permission to take out the disposed vehicle from ICHR premises will not be allowed on holidays, Saturdays and Sundays etc.
5. In case the bidder is a company, the name of the company should be indicated as the bidder. In such cases the person appearing for the company should have the authorization letter in a proper format issued from a competent authority of the company. Request to change the name of the bidder will not be entertained afterwards.
6. The bidder is required to reveal his full name/name of the authorized signatory of the firm/name of father, full postal address, telephone number & mobile number
7. The person authorized by bidder will be allowed to take the delivery. The successful bidder should furnish identity and Residential address proofs. The bidder is required to produce any of following documents as documentary evidence for proof of their address. (Ration Card/ Voters Identity Card in case of individual and Registration Certificate in case of firms etc.)
8. The ICHR reserves the right to accept/reject any offer/bid without assigning any reason

whatsoever.

9. The bidder may inspect the above vehicle on any working day from 09.01.2020 to 14.01.2020 between 11am to 4 pm with prior appointment with the Caretaker, Indian Council of Historical Research, 35 Ferozeshah Road, New Delhi-110001 on telephone no.23385606. No request for inspection after 14.01.2020 will be accepted. No Complaint whatsoever will be entertained afterwards.
10. The successful bidder will also be responsible for getting the Registration Certificate of the vehicle transferred in his name at his own cost expeditiously. ICHR will not be responsible for any lapse on his part in this regard.
11. ICHR will not owe any other liability for using this vehicle for commercial or other purpose after sale.
12. Employees of ICHR and their family members are not eligible to participate in the auction.
13. Once the release order is issued, this office will not be responsible either for safe custody or for any loss or damage to the subject vehicle.
14. Disputes, if any, shall be subject to jurisdiction in the Court of Delhi only.
