

ICHR-JSPS Bilateral Programme Call for applications for the year 2019-20

The Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR), New Delhi and the Japan Society for the Promotion of Science (JSPS), have collaboration for research in the field of History.

The ICHR invites research/seminar proposals from Indian scholars engaged in historical research. The theme of the proposal should either be related to India or Japan or a comparative study covering India and Japan. The purpose of the call is to build on the combined strengths of academic research groups within the India and Japan to work together on collaborative.

Proposals must include at least one researcher from both India and Japan with a lead researcher (Principal Investigator/Seminar Coordinator) in each country. The Indian Principal Investigator/ Seminar Coordinator and Principal Investigator/ Seminar Coordinator from Japan will submit a matching application for funding. Applications submitted by one side only will not be accepted. The ICHR and JSPS will jointly fund successful applications.
