Sub Units of the Southern Regional Centre

The Southern Regional Centre is functioning as the Regional Centre and consists of Sub-Units of -

Approval Authority

All the payments and decisions are made by the Competent Authority of our Council. The payment note/proposals are regularly sent to Director (R&A)/Member Secretary. The decisions and approvals taken at Head Office are conveyed to the Southern Regional Centre. Accordingly, the Southern Regional Centre implements the decision/approvals.

Southern Regional Centre Office Building:

Both, Government of Karnataka and Bangalore University jointly invited the Council to establish the Regional Centre of Indian Council of Historical Research [ICHR] in the Central College campus. The ICHR had initiated and established its Regional Office in the old Law College building in 1998. The building is a century old building of Heritage. The Bangalore University with the approval of the Syndicate and approval of Government of Karnataka allotted this building on Lease for a period of 30 years from 1998. Out of 30 years, 25 years have been completed. Meanwhile the Bangalore University has been divided into three separate Universities. The Central College campus is made as a new University, now known as Bengaluru City University. Along with ICHR's Regional Centre, there are other regional offices such as UGC, AICTE, Sahitya Akademi, etc., in the same campus. The newly established University Bengaluru City University took decision to claim and vacate the offices of ICHR and others. The ICHR Southern Regional Centre received a notice from the Bengaluru City University to vacate and hand over the building to the Bengaluru City University. The Council made a request to the Bengaluru City University to continue the Regional Centre till the completion of Lease period i.e. till the year 2028. However, the Bengaluru City University made a legal case and approached the judicial court in 2019. The Southern Regional Centre has also made a request to the Hon'ble Civil Court. Meanwhile, the Bengaluru City University took decision to withdraw the court cases against the ICHR and other offices. The case was withdrawn in January 2022. Presently the Southern Regional Centre is functioning in the same building.

Repairs

Presently the building is heavily leaking and a proposal of repairs has been put up by the Southern Regional Centre to Head Office. The repair works are urgently needed and it is recommended to take up the repair works on priority.






Academic Works and Achievements of the Southern Regional Centre

A comprehensive report on the works and achievements made by Southern Regional Centre is given below.

PART-1: ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES

The Centre from its inception has taken various steps in promoting the Council's the Research Schemes and historical research in southern states. The Centre has taken-up Projects, conducting Seminars and Periodical Lectures and building up of the Library-cum-Documentation Unit. The details are as follows-

I. PROJECTS – Completed

Since the Centre is actively participating in coordinating the research in the field of regional history of south India a large number of sources are available in vernacular languages of south and these are urgently need for the scholars for their study, the Centre has taken up the task of bringing these source materials particularly epigraphical sources and also important historical writings available in vernacular languages. The Centre has taken up the translation, editing and publication of the Projects. The details are as follows-

(i) Reproduction of 100 years old EpigraphiaCarnaticaVolumes

The Government of Princely Mysore through its Archaeological Department had brought out inscription of Karnataka in 15 volumes entitled *Epigraphia Carnatica*. The editor of the series was the great B.L. Rice. These volumes printed between 1885-1905 are out of print for over 75 years. Even some University libraries do not have them. The Centre made all efforts to procure these old volumes from different individuals. The photocopies of all these volumes were readied by the Centre and kept in the Centre's library for the use of scholars. The Southern Regional Centre library is the onely proud possessor of all those volumes at one place.

(ii) CD-RoM of EpigraphiaCarnatica Volumes

To cope with the revolution in Information Technology and to adopt ourselves the Centre took up the work of producing the Karnataka inscriptions in one CD-RoM. This is a project which reproduces 15 volumes of the *Epigraphia Carnatica* edited by B.L. Rice, M.H. Krishn and R. Narasimhachar. The CD-RoM Project taken up in September 1998 was completed in January 2000. A total 15,283 pages of the volumes have been scanned by the M/s. Newgen Software Technologies Pvt. Ltd., Bangalore. Indexes on dynasty, date, location of the inscriptions have been prepared and entered. Scholars can have easy access to 32,889 inscriptions in one CD. The CD has been released by our Hon'ble Chairman, Professor D.N. Tripathi on 10th September 2005 in Bangalore. The Centre has completed this significant Project.

II SEMINARS & SYMPOSIUMS

The Southern Regional Centre in view to bring the consolidated ideas and research on history of south India various aspects of south Indian history, several Seminars were conducted. The Seminars are being held at International, National, Regional and State levels.

So far, the Centre has organized **ONE** International Seminar, **NINE** National Seminars, **THREE** Regional Level Seminars and **ELEVEN**State-level Seminars. The State-level Seminars are organized in collaboration with the Universities/ Research Institutes of the respective states.

Digital Archival Programme

The rare collections of historical and archival sources particularly visual documents of primary sources, sketches, maps, etc., available in various Web based sites like British Library, Google Books, ColumbiaUniversity Library, Archives.org, etc. The Centre is making efforts to collect these available archival collections by accessing the Internet sites and storing in the form of CDs. These collected net-based books are stored individually in separate CDs. The catalogue of these collected net-based books is being undertaken. Nearly 180 rare / old archival books have been collected during the period under report. The importance of this digital archival collection lies in its rare and important source materials for historical research. 18th; 19th and early 20th century publications, original Sannads, documents, papers, diaries, photographs, etc. are collected and make available for students. Collections of these rare archival sources is well received by scholars. The digital archival source collection is being developed in Centre's Library-cum-Documentation Unit.

Collection of popular articles: The Library-Cum-Documentation Unit has made provision to provide popular articles on various aspects like regional history, philosophy, places of interest, folklore, rituals, traditions, etc., which are published in weekly supplementary issues of the daily Newspapers (both English and regional languages). These articles have been kept under separate files for scholars use.

Computerization of the Library-cum-Documentation Unit: The Centre's Library-cum-Documentation Unit with the help of National Informatics Centre, Bangalore, KarnatakaState has made efforts to computerize Library data and made easy access to the scholars. The NIC has provided library software and data of the library were incorporated. Now the Centre's Library-cum-Documentation Unit is computerized. It was inaugurated in September 2004 by our Hon'ble Chairman Prof. D.N. Tripathi. The scholars are making use of this facility.

However, the manual Index Cards (on Titles and Author) have been done for all the books accessed for the library. It is kept open for scholar's use.

Modernizing Library Catalogue: During the reporting period, the Centre took major step to modernize library catalogue. The computerization of library catalogues was completed. In addition to computerization of library catalogues, the bar code facility system to all the library books and periodicals was undertaken. With the help of University Library Science students, the Centre completed the bar code facility and also stock verification of the library collection. The

work was completed during the reporting period and total 16,000 titles are provided with bar code stickers.

New Library Software Installation (LIBSYS) The Library software – LIBSYS – has been installed in the library in the year 2011. This will help the scholars to go for INTRA Library Network with the Head Office Library and Libraries of the two Regional Centres. With this new software installation, one can search the library catalogue by internet, web-search anywhere in India or abroad.

Services to Students and Teachers – Online study materials: Due to Corona and guidelines of Lockdown in the year 2020, the academic institutions line Universities, had not kept their libraries open. Teachers and students have been requesting the Southern Regional Centre to send the scanned images of required source materials for their studies. The Centre initiated new services from June 2020 onwards, to provide the reading materials to the teachers and students across the region. The Southern Regional Centre circulated an intimation letters to PG department of History and allied subjects of Universities of southern India intimating that the Southern Regional Centre will forward through online the reading materials from the published journals and books to the teachers and students. Good responses were received from south Indian Universities and Southern Regional Centre has taken this opportunity to serve the scholars, students and teachers.

2. Physical Verification Committee Visit:

The Physical Verification Committee comprising of Sri. S. RangabashiamDy.Director (Admin.),Sri. Anil Sainger, Dy. Director (Accounts), Dr. [Mrs.] Jyotsna Arora Dy. Director (Library) and Sri. Shashi Kumar Asst. Director (Grants) visited the Southern Regional Centre, Bangalore visited Centre from 6th to 8th August 2012. The Committee inspected and verified the office assets and library collections. The Committee also verified and made list of the library books with the library accession registers. The Committee expressed its satisfaction of the assets and their maintenance by the SRC.

The Committee comprising of the members Sri. S. Rangabashiam Dy. Director (Admin.), Sri. Anil Sainger, Dy. Director (Accounts) and Sri. Shashi Kumar Asst. Director (Grants) visited the Centre between 11th and 14th June 2013 and has undertaken the complete verification of all the assets and library books of the Centre as per the Stock and Accession Registers.

On 28th June 2013 Sri. S. Rangabashiam Dy. Director (Admin.), visited the Centre again for rechecking the library books.

6. COVID-19 Pandemic and Precautionary Measures undertaken by SRC

The Nation-wide lockdown/curfew was announced for 21 days w.e.f. 25 March 2020 to 14 April 2020, for the containment of the Covid-19 pandemic. The office was closed during the closedown period. In the second and third phase of Lockdown, from 15 April 2020 – 17 May 2020, the office functioned with 33% staff. During this period, the office premises was cleaned up and precaution was taken to prevent the public entry to the office library. From 18th May to 31st December 2020, the roaster method was followed in the office with 50% staff every day. In-between, the Government of Karnataka had announced second time lock down of Bangalore city w.e.f. 14th to 21st July 2020. The office was kept closed during this lockdown period. The Centre is functioning regularly from February 2022.

As per the Library Accession Register, 14194 titles are registered as purchased books for SRC Library from its inception, i.e., 1998. This collection excludes Complimentary titles donated to SRC.

Conduct of the Physical Stock Verification

As directed by the Head Office's Library, the books in the Library Collection were physically checked, verified and Noted in the sheets. All the books from racks and almirahs have been listed. After the listing, the same were checked and verified with the Library Accession Register and these have been marked as checked and verified.

Duration of the Physical Stock Verification

Physical Stock Verification of total number of 14194 books was under taken in 20 working days. The Stock Verification work took 14 working days for counting and listing from library collections, and the remaining days for checking the books in the Accession Register.

Summary

With reference to the Head Office Order, the Physical Stock Verification of Library-cum-Documentation Unit of the Centre was conducted in September-October 2022. In the Stock Verification process, all the books from the Library (purchased only) were physically verified and checked with the Library Accession Register. Only 27 books are found missing against the 14194 books. An average library consultation by the students and scholars is 15-20, on regular basis. The Library Physical Stock Verification was conducted and completed. It is hereby submitted a Brief Report along with the Summary.

Status of Ongoing Research Projects

The Regional Centre, Bengaluru, is promoting research in Regional History by undertaking Research Projects. A Project on CD RoM on *Epigraphia Carnatica*, publication of epigraphical volumes of Vijayanagara, Chalukyas of Badami, Kakatiyas of Warangal, Sanskrit Inscriptions had been undertaken and completed. Following are the on-going Research Projects in which Regional Centre is actively participating and conducting.

- ➤ Preparation of the Corpus of Kannada and Sanskrit Inscriptions of the Yadavas of Devagiri of the Deccan.
- ➤ Compilation and editing of the *Rashtrakuta Inscriptions from South India* into a volume.

I Preparation of the Corpus of Kannada and Sanskrit Inscriptions of the Yadavas of Devagiri of the Deccan.

Yadavas of Devagiri ruled from c.1000 AD to c.1320 AD and they contributed for growth of art and culture. Their inscriptions are found in Karnataka, Maharashtra and Telangana. These inscriptions are in Kannada, Sanskrit, Marathi and a few are in Telugu.

The aim of the Project is to collect the details of the published inscriptions from various sources. The data collection from the published inscriptions are being collected by the SRC academic staff. The model of the data collection is as follows-

Status: The publications of *Epigraphia Carnatica*, *Epigraphia Indica*, *South Indian Inscriptions*, *Karnataka Inscriptions*, Inscription volumes published by Kannada University, Hampi and also from Journals, etc., have been collected. So far **three hundred (300) plus** data sheets have been prepared and same will be entered into computer data. Another 250 inscriptions are expected to be studied for compilation. The work is in progress

II Compilation and editing of the Rashtrakuta Inscriptions from South India into a volume.

Rashtrakutas are known for their contribution to Kannada literature and architecture. The first Kannada literary work *Kavirajamarga* was composed and authored by the famous Rashtrakuta king Amoghavarsha. Famous temples at Yellora, Elephanta, Sirivala, etc., were constructed under the patronage of Rashtrakutas. The inscriptions of the Rashtrakutas are found in various parts of southern India.

pilot Project the Council has identified to begin and compile the history of villages and towns of Shivamogga district of Karnataka state. The Southern Regional Centre of ICHR is given responsibility to assist as the Nodal Office for this Research Project.
